

It's getting close to back- to-school time again, and soon Religious Education classes will begin.



# Welcome, Father John Chmil!

On Friday, September 1st, Father John Chmil will become the second pastor of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton! We warmly welcome him to our parish as pastor!

My name is Fr. John Chmil and I very excited to walk with you, as of September 1<sup>st</sup>. My parents are the Late Paul John Chmil Sr., who passed into eternal life on August 17, 2013 and Regina Ann (Sharkey) Chmil, who is 85 years old and who lives with me. My parents loved one another for over 53 years. They met at Wyoming Seminary Business School after graduating from High School. My Mom gave birth to me at the Nesbitt Hospital on June 20, 1966. My brother Paul, my sister Kim



and I were raised in a loving family. Our parents dedicated their lives to us and nurtured us with love. We are not perfect, and we turn to Jesus, in the Sacrament of Reconciliation, when we need to be forgiven. We are blessed and we treasure the gift of our family life.

My life as a priest, mirrors my upbringing. Family and faith are at the core of who I am and what I share with people. My faith began by being baptized at Saint Leo's Parish in Ashley, and attending Mass with my Mom as well as, my brother and sister. My father was Russian Orthodox and belonged to Saint Nicholas Russian Orthodox Church on Seneca Street in Wilkes-Barre. We also went to church with my Dad and learned a lot about ecumenism, even before we knew what that meant.

My assignments include: being stationed as an Assistant Pastor: at Saint Nicholas Church in Wilkes-Barre, Saint Peter's Cathedral in Scranton and Saint Matthew's Church in East Stroudsburg; being stationed as a Pastor at Saint Lucy's Church and linked with Saints Peter and Paul Church in West Scranton, Saint Peter and Paul Church in Towanda and linked with Saint Michael's Church in Canton, Saint Aloysious Church in Ralston and Saint John's Church in Troy, Saint Peter's Church in Wellsboro with a Mission named Sacred Heart Church in Morris, Saint Ignatius Church in Kingston and Saint Ann Church in Williamsport.

My years in the Priesthood are filled with joy and Jesus has used the laity as an instrument in each of these assignments - to mold me and to heal me as needed. So, I come to you and walk with you in faith. My desire is - to share my inner life with you, to work hard as my parents have taught me, and for all of us, to grow closer with Christ.

My prayers are with you and Fr. Joe. Please pray for me and for Saint Ann's Parish in Williamsport. When we love, departing is difficult, as the intimacy we have runs deep. You know what that means, as Fr. Joe moves to Shavertown.

### **10 Years and Change**

My Dear Parishioners:

The time has come. The past 12 years have been the best years of my life thus far. I have enjoyed every minute of being your shepherd. Looking back on so many things that have happened to us in the course of the last decade or so, I feel one thing: Grateful. Grateful to God for allowing this time to happen. Grateful for the tremendously talented staff that have come together to serve you. Grateful to each of you for allowing me in your lives to share a couple of minutes on a Sunday and those important moments of life which I treasure. We comforted one another at the loss of loved ones, rejoiced together at Baptisms and Weddings, Prayed in the hospital or nursing home together, laughed at parish gatherings and fundraisers. Ate at the Festivals and the many food raisers. It has all been a time so graced for me. I will never forget that in the middle of COVID you reached out to me and my family when my mom passed-away.

We've witnessed our parishes change from two worship spaces to one. We've worshiped together in the magnificent structure of Holy Trinity Church, in the basement for a while and even the parish gymnasium at times. We've put in new sound systems, an organ, a piano, we knocked down houses and paved a parking lot, we put in a driveway, repointed the school, lit the church with new lighting, new carpets, new floors, moved lots of stuff around, decorated our church to the 9's. Sang and prayed our hearts out at liturgies, started a Sunday afternoon mass, put in highly sophisticated livestreaming capabilities, Put in a new staircase at the entrance of our church, repainted statues, repaired walls and plaster, painted part of the church, put in a modern, comfortable confessional and so much more.

Our church changed during these past 12 years in unexpected and unpleasant ways: Our mass changed its familiar wording, the re-opening of the past scandals and cover-up. We elected a new pope who has even a great love for change than I do. We had to actually close our doors during the pandemic —- who could ever imagine such a thing.
