

4th Sunday of Easter

A very experienced nun taught the fifth grade class in our parish school. The class was a smart bunch, with strong personalities and a very competitive spirit. But they picked on students who were different, or who were slower, or who had physical or learning difficulties, without realizing just how hurtful they could be. Through a series of activities and conversations, the good sister helped students see how everyone had something to contribute to the class. They discovered they were more alike than different and a new spirit of cooperation and respect soon emerged in the class. She knew that once they knew the person who went with the name, they would better appreciate each other and be a bit more accepting of one another's shortcomings.

Our homes need to be places of acceptance and support, places where we are known and loved for who we are and what we offer that makes our family and our marriage unique. There will be times of conflict and moments that will test every virtue we have. But home needs to be a secure place where we learn to be ourselves, and where we see that we are more alike than we are different. Wherever we go, we take a bit of home with us. It is the moral compass that keeps us straight and the example of love that keeps us secure. Give your loved ones a bit of room to stretch and grow, to make mistakes and recover, to find their strength and their weakness, and to experience themselves in the safety of your love.
