

Deeply shaken, Pope Leo XIII immediately composed the Prayer to Saint Michael as a spiritual battle cry. A call for heavenly protection against the powers of darkness.

PRAYER TO ST. MICHAEL

"Saint Michael the Archangel, defend us in battle. Be our protection against the wickedness and snares of the devil. May God rebuke him, we humbly pray, and do thou, O Prince of the Heavenly Host, by the power of God, cast into hell, Satan and all the evil spirits who prowl about the world seeking the ruin of souls. Amen."

The history of this prayer: Yes, a prayer can be inspired by a battle, especially a spiritual one. Pope Leo XIII's Prayer to St. Michael the Archangel is one such powerful example, born from a vivid & terrifying vision he reportedly experienced in 1884. According to tradition, after celebrating Mass, Pope Leo XIII collapsed & appeared to be in a trance-like state. When he awoke, he described a vision of Satan boasting to God that he could destroy the Church if given a century & more power. What followed was a horrific scene of demonic attacks & chaos. But then St. Michael the Archangel appeared, casting the evil spirits back into Hell by the power of God.

It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-HourChild Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis. To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.


