

Festival Wrap-up & Looking Ahead....

Once again, the mighty arm of Seton was flexed the week of July 13-15th as we celebrated our Summer Festival! So many happy people were here on our grounds enjoying the music, fellowship, games and most of all the food that was prepared by so many of our parishioners. As I said at the midnight mass following the Festival, a simple "Thank You," is not enough. But it will have to do along with the joy brought to so many through your efforts. I cannot even begin to list (on paper) all those who need a special shout-out, but you all know who you are, and I know who you are. As far as numbers go, we won't have the final tally for quite some time as we await all the bills and extra income to be collected. However, just the 3 nights of the Festival brought in over \$133,000.00 (excluding pre-sales of tickets, raffles, sponsors, donations, etc.) We did extremely well and again, it is all thanks to your hard work.

While I have your attention, let me mention what I reported to the diocese about work that is needed to be done to our buildings by the new pastor. While not urgent for the most part, these are projects that will need to be addressed in the near future: New roof for the church. It has been since 1994 since it was replaced, it's getting to be time with each passing storm more and more shingles are falling off. The stonework at the base of the church needs to be replaced. It has eroded quite a bit and is going to cause bigger problems if not addressed soon. The boilers in the rectory, church and school will eventually need to be replaced as they are past the expiration date. The church needs to be painted. If you look closely, the paint is peeling in spots and there are stains and just lots of dirt from candles and smoke that have accumulated over the past 30 years. Finally, the rectory needs work, perhaps a complete renovation. There is no rest room on the first floor which makes anyone with disabilities unable to use the bathroom while visiting. Carpets need replacing, paneling and paint need to be updated and more odds and ends need to be done in order to keep up the building. I apologize for my lack of interest in doing things in the rectory, I personally felt that the work we did in and around the church was more important, but the time has come. There is enough to keep the finance council and the new pastor busy for quite some time. The good news is that funds are available to do the work with the accounts that are held by the diocese for such projects. (\$1,683,649.00) is the latest number that I have of our Diocesan Savings Accounts. ~~Father Joe

Saint Ignatius of Loyola

orn in his family's ancestral Basque castle, Inigo Lopez de Loyola was a page in Castile and a soldier wounded in battle before he experienced a personal conversion that has had profound consequences for the church ever since. While convalescing, he read about Christ and the saints, made a long retreat at Manresa and journeyed to Jerusalem. He studied for 10 years in Barcelona and Paris, where he became Ignatius and was the center of a group of like-minded men. They founded the Society of Jesus, or Jesuits, to be active missionaries and meet the challenges of the Reformation. Ignatius, superior general of the new order, also wrote "Spiritual Exercises," which is still a popular guide. He is the patron saint of retreats and soldiers.



Our Jesuit coat of arms is a monogram bearing the acronym of 'Iesus Hominum Salvator'. . . But this coat of arms constantly reminds us of a reality we must never forget: the centrality of Christ, for each one of us and for the whole Society which St Ignatius wanted to call, precisely, 'of Jesus' to indicate its point of reference. . . Because there is always a temptation to think that we are at the center; and when a Jesuit puts himself and not Christ at the center he errs.



orn near Lyon, France, this farmer's son studied for the priesthood for many years, and eventually was ordained more for his devoutness and good will than for other qualities. But he became a model parish priest in Arsen-Dombes, where he served for 40 years. He was devoted to his parishioners, and became famous for rigorous preaching and insights in the confessional. The Cure of Ars, as he was known, spent up to 18 hours a day hearing the confessions of pilgrims who sought him out. He is the patron of parish priests.

It is the policy of the Diocese of Scranton to report any allegation of sexual abuse of a minor to law enforcement. If you are a victim of sexual abuse committed by a priest, deacon, religious or lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton, you are encouraged to immediately report the matter to law enforcement. If any priest, deacon, religious, lay employee or volunteer of the Diocese of Scranton has cause or reason to suspect that a minor has been subjected to any form of abuse, including child sexual abuse, the matter will be reported to law enforcement.

It is also the policy of the Diocese to adhere to all civil and state regulations. In accordance with the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania's Child Protective Services Laws, reports of suspected child abuse should also be made immediately by phone to the 24-HourChild Abuse hotline (ChildLine) at 1-800-932-0313 or electronically at www.compass.state.pa.us/cwis. To this end, the Diocese is equally committed to adhering to the norms of the Code of Canon Law and to upholding the tenets of the USCCB Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, which includes supporting victims of sexual abuse in their pursuit of emotional and spiritual well-being. As such, information regarding an allegation of

sexual abuse of a minor should also be reported to the Victim Assistance Coordinator Mary Beth Pacuska at 570-862-7551.


