

Celebrating 175 Years

The Sisters of Christian Charity, founded by Pauline von Mallinckrodt, in Paderborn, Germany, are celebrating their 175th Anniversary as a Congregation. It is also the 150th Anniversary of the Sisters arriving at St. Nicholas Parish Wilkes-Barre on October 15, 1873. Soon after their arrival Father Nagle asked other German Pastors if they wanted Sisters to teach in their parish school. The response was a whole-hearted yes and as a result, the Congregation grew quickly in the United States. The "Cradle" of the Congregation in the United States was established in Wilkes-Barre, with the building of Mallinckrodt Convent as the motherhouse in 1877, in addition to a school for girls known as St. Ann's Academy. The motherhouse was transferred to Illinois (1916) and then to New Jersey (1927). St. Ann's Academy remained open until 1971. Wyoming Valley also became home to the Sisters serving in the following parishes: St. Nicholas /St. Nicholas-St. Mary, Bishop Hoban/Holy Redeemer High School, St. Boniface, Wilkes-Barre; Sacred Heart, Luzerne; St. Mary Assumption, Pittston; St. Jude Mountain Top; and Kingston Central Catholic/Bishop O'Reilly High School.

Bishop Bambera will celebrate the Eucharistic Liturgy in St. Nicholas Church on November 4, at 12 p.m. We look forward to seeing you to help celebrate this momentous event.
